## **RULES THE FOLLOWING**

### **Art. 1 (Purpose of the contract and general rules)**

This announcement details the enrolment procedures to PhD research courses, XXIX cycle, referred to in the enclosed prospectus, an integral part of this announcement, with administrative offices at the University of Milano-Bicocca, with courses beginning in **January 2014**.

Any amendments and additions to this notice will be posted on the website of the University (<http://www.unimib.it/go/243995352>).

The submission of the application for admission, according to the procedures laid down in Article 3 and 4, is pending upon the applicant satisfying all the requirements contained in this announcement. Non-compliance with said requirements by the applicant will result in exclusion from the competition.

All communications to applicants concerning this notice will occur via e-mail. For this purpose, we will use the e-mail address specified by the applicant during the registration process at the site (Art. 3).

For each course we have provided the following details: length in years, the number of available seats, with specific scholarships, training contracts, and any other forms of financial support, from funds for research or other resources of the University, including research grants as well as any seats without scholarship, the procedures of admission examinations, any seats reserved for special categories, to be assigned by a distinct order of merit ranking, as well as the opportunity for applicants to choose whether to take the exams in Italian or any other languages.

The number of scholarships will be increased as a result of funding from public and private entities, as long as notification is provided by 23 September 2013. The increase in the number of scholarships may determine an increase in overall number of competing seats. The additional places will be made known with a subsequent decree which will be published by 1 November 2013.

### **Art. 2 (Eligibility)**

Those who comply with the following requirements for 15 years or less may apply for admission, without limitation of citizenship;

- Post-graduate Degree;
- Degree, obtained under the laws previously in force to Ministerial Decree. 509/1999 (university degree Old Regulations);
- Degree qualification obtained abroad, provided it is equivalent in duration, level and subject area to the Italian title that allows access to the course. The suitability of a foreign qualification is assessed by the Selection Board, subject to examination by the competent offices of the requirements of the current legislation in Italy and in the country where the title itself was awarded and the international treaties or agreements concerning the recognition of certificates for the continuation of studies.
- Final-year students may apply for admission, provided they qualify by 31 January 2014. By that date, under penalty of forfeiture of admission, the PhD applicants are required to communicate the date and

score of the degree obtained by e-mail to [dottorati@unimib.it](mailto:dottorati@unimib.it), including any Italian or EU citizenship statement in lieu of certification.

The sheets attached to this notice shall specify for each PhD course the type of qualification required for participation in the assessments and any additional requirements.

Those already enrolled in the same doctoral Course cannot apply for admission.

### **Art. 3 (Applications for admission)**

To participate in the admission test, all applicants, with the exception of the categories referred to in Article 4, must submit their application electronically, directly from the website of the University of Milano-Bicocca [www.unimib.it](http://www.unimib.it), by accessing the Online Secretariats **no later than the deadline of 12 noon on 16 October 2013**.

Applicants who are not yet registered in the system must first register their personal details and then log into the system (login) with their login information.

The applicants already registered will have direct access to the system (login) using their personal login information.

It is mandatory to include detailed documentation such as i.d. documentation and a passport photo in digital format with a resolution of at least 300x400 pixels.

At the conclusion of the procedure, click the appropriate button to print the application form, which shall include the electronic MAV bill of € 50.00 as a fee which shall be paid at any branch of all banks. Payment must be made no later than 16 October 2013. If payment is not made by such date, it will not be possible for the applicants to go through the assessment stage.

Only payments made within that deadline will be deemed valid and, therefore, any claim for loss or late payment, will be considered as unacceptable, even if it is not the applicant's fault.

If necessary, you can print the receipt again by reconnecting to the On Line Secretariats.

The payment must be made for each application submitted.

The payment receipt must be kept in a safe place by the interested party. The university Administration reserves the right to ask for written proof of payment.

In the event of non-participation in the entrance exam, the above-mentioned contribution will not be reimbursed. The day of the first exam the applicant have to give the signed application for admission to the Committee for examination.

The applicants who have obtained qualifications from abroad must submit an application in the manner set out in Article. 4.

Applicants may apply for disability assistance and DSA for the carrying out of the examination. For this purpose,

in addition to filling in the questionnaire during the procedure of entering the competition, such applicants should contact by the registration deadline of the test, the Service for students with disabilities and DSA, [servizi.disabili.dsa@unimib.it](mailto:servizi.disabili.dsa@unimib.it) in order to send the diagnosis certification and the request for such assistance.

Under Article. 75 of the Presidential Decree n. 445/2000, if the Administration finds, on the basis of appropriate cheques, that the statements made by the applicant are not truthful, the declarant shall forfeit any benefits obtained by the measure adopted on the basis of false declarations.

The university Administration has no responsibility in the event of loss of communications, due to errors in the address or e-mail by the applicant, by failure or late notification of change of address, or for any postal, wire or telecommunication errors are not attributable to the Administration.

#### **Art. 4**

##### **Application for admission for non-EU citizens and Italian citizens with qualifications obtained abroad**

Applicants holding a degree comparable in duration and content to the Italian academic qualification required for admission to the chosen course may register.

The equivalence of the qualification for the sole purpose of admission to the doctorate, will be decided by the Selection Committee. In the event of a negative decision, the applicant will be disqualified.

All EU and non-EU citizens and Italian citizens with qualifications from abroad must submit **a paper application** using the template available on the website of the University at the link <http://www.unimib.it/go/10131458>, according to the procedures set out in paragraphs A and B below, **within the date of expiry of this notice.**

The application must specify whether the applicant intends to take the entrance exam to secure a regular or reserved spot, if provided for and the type of reserve. You cannot participate in both types of selection procedures.

##### **A. EU citizens - Non-EU citizens legally residing in Italy and Italian citizens with qualifications obtained abroad**

EU citizens residing everywhere, non-EU citizens legally resident in Italy under Article 26 of Law No. 189 of 30.07.2002 and Italian citizens with qualifications from abroad must submit directly the following documentation to the University Foreign Office at this University in U17 Piazza Difesa per le Donne - Milan (hours of operation: Tuesday and Thursday from 10 am to 12 am) or via email to [foreign.office@unimib.it](mailto:foreign.office@unimib.it) and [dottorati@unimib.it](mailto:dottorati@unimib.it) before the expiration date of this announcement,;

- if the foreign degree has not already been declared equivalent to an Italian degree required for admission to the course
  - a paper application (in which the applicant must make an explicit request for equivalence, for the sole purpose of admission to the course in question);
  - qualification certificate in original or replacement format for all purposes of the law;
  - official translation into Italian and legalised diploma;
  - "Declaration of equivalence of certification" by the Italian diplomatic or consular territorial jurisdiction in the State whose law pertains to the qualification itself;
  - all the necessary documentation to enable the Selection Committee to issue a declaration of equivalence which may be in Italian or English;
  - copy of passport/i.d. documentation;
  - copy of residence permit (only for non-EU applicants).

- if the foreign degree has already been deemed equivalent to an Italian degree required for admission to the course
  - a paper application (in which the applicant must indicate the details of the Decree of equivalence and the Italian university that issued it);
  - copy of passport/i.d. documentation;
  - copy of residence permit (only for non-EU applicants).

The following are equivalent to EU citizens:

- the citizens of Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein
- the citizens of Switzerland
- the citizens of the Republic of San Marino

## **B. Non-EU citizens residing abroad**

Non-EU citizens residing abroad will send the following via email to [foreign.office@unimib.it](mailto:foreign.office@unimib.it) and [dottorati@unimib.it](mailto:dottorati@unimib.it)

- a paper application;
- copy of the education qualification certificate;
- copy of passport/i.d. documentation.

Applicants who are to participate in the admission tests, which requires that the applicant be physically present in Italy, will require from the diplomatic or consular Authority a short-stay visa for study purposes; later, following the presentation of documentation attesting passing the entrance examinations, the Authority itself will issue to the applicants, who returned to their country after having passed the above tests, a new entry visa for study/University of validity related to that of course.

At the same time the applicants who passed the examination must turn over to the diplomatic or consular the following documentation:

- official translation into Italian and legalised diploma;
- "Declaration of certificate of equivalence of qualification" by the Italian diplomatic or consular territorial jurisdiction in the State whose law refers to the qualification itself,

to be presented on enrolment with:

- qualification in original or replacement certificate for all purposes of the law.

EU citizens who do not meet the requirements of Article 39 of Legislative Decree No. 30.07.1998 nr. 286 as amended by article 26 of Law nr. 189 of 30.07.2002 (not resident in Italy) are exempt from the payment of the participation in the entrance exam of € 50.00.

For this category, the registration, subject to the delivery of the consular visa or the receipt of the request of a residence permit for study/university purposes, must be submitted by the closing date indicated in the notification of admission, or otherwise it will be denied.

The seats that are left open for lack of qualification or waiver enrolment, will be made available to the applicants who classified later in the ranking. According to the University Regulations for the implementation of the Law of 7 August 1990 nr. 241, registration procedures for foreign nationals will be deemed to be completed after 120 days from the date of the decree of the entrance exam approval.

#### **Rules that apply to all applicants:**

The declaration of merit shall indicate the final grade for the diploma and the scale value at which the grade relates. In the absence of these elements, in accordance with the list of qualified applicants, the score will be calculated on the minimum grade.

The declaration of merit shall also state that the academic degree is valid in the country it was earned for enrolment in a comparable course in the PhD curriculum.

If the degree was earned at European universities, it is possible, as an alternative to the declaration of merit, to present the Diploma Supplement legalised by the competent authorities.

Undergraduates must be received by the closing date of this notice, a certificate showing the list of exams taken, or they won't be admitted to the exam.

#### **Art. 5 (Admission)**

Admission is carried out according to the procedures described for each course in the schedule in this Decree.

The selection procedure, in order to ascertain the applicant's aptitude for scientific research, is an assessment of the applicants' qualifications and publications supplemented, in accordance with each of the Academic Boards, by a written test and/or an oral examination.

Any oral examination is public.

The Committee has a total of 80 points in total at its disposal. 20 points are reserved to the assessment of qualifications and publications. The evaluation of qualifications is made by the selection committee before the oral examination and, if preceded by a written test, before correction of the same.

The tests are total of 60 points. In order to pass the exam, it is necessary to have an overall assessment of at least 40 points. If there are two attempts, each is worth 30 points; passing for each test is a minimum score of 20 points.

The final score is the sum of the points given in the assessment of qualifications, publications and tests.

**Publication of the date of the examination referred to in the attached schedule is considered official notification to all intents and purposes.**

To take the examination, applicants must have valid i.d. documentation, as mentioned in the admission phase.

#### **Art. 6 (Certificates: delivery and return)**

All certificates must be submitted **by the closing date of this announcement**, in the manner prescribed for each course in the schedule to this notice.

In the event of postal delivery, **the stamp will not be accepted.**

Under Article 40 of the Presidential Decree n. 445/2000, as amended by art. 15 of Law No. 183/2011, certificates issued by the Public Administration must be declared by self-certification upon admission to the entrance exam. To do this, applicants can make use of self-certification models available on the website at <http://www.unimib.it/go/10131458>.

The declaration made by the applicant, which substitutes certification for all intents and purposes, must contain all the elements needed to evaluate the certificate to be produced. The omission of even one element involves the non-assessment of the self-certified qualification. Certificates issued by private entities or obtained abroad can be produced:

- a) in the original
- b) a certified copy
- c) in the original copy certified by a declaration together with the application for admission.

Failure to provide any of the certificates does not invalidate the application for admission, but does not allow its evaluation.

After the ban expiration date, statements, certificates and publications will not be taken into consideration.

The certificates submitted in original or certified copy shall be returned, at the request of the interested party after 120 days following the publication of the lists. The Applicants shall, at their own expense, within six months after completion of the entrance exam, get back the certificates and the publications sent to the University; afterwards, the Administration will not be responsible for the safekeeping of the tiles and publications

#### **Art. 7 (Selection Committee)**

The Committees for examinations for admission to PhD courses will be formed and appointed in accordance with local regulations.

#### **Art. 8 (Rankings and how to subscribe)**

The merit list of the applicants are formed according to the descending order of overall scores obtained by each applicant and shall be published in the Official Register of the University and on the website <http://www.unimib.it/go/216341175>. Only the rankings published on this page of the website will allow the applicants to enrol in each Course.

The above-mentioned rules regarding the publication of the lists and enrolment terms, are considered official in all respects. **There will be no personal interaction with the participants**, except in the event of filling a vacancy.

Applicants are admitted to the course according to the ranking list and up to the number of seats available.

The scholarships, as per art. 9, are assigned according to the order of the ranking. In the event of a tie, the assessment of the economic situation determined under the regulations in force regarding the right to education will be the deciding factor. In the event of a further tie, the younger applicant will be assigned the spot.

If the Committee has drawn up a list for each curriculum, applicants are admitted to each curriculum as long as there are seats available in that curriculum. If a curriculum enrolls a lower number of applicants than the number of seats with scholarships, the remaining scholarships can be assigned to applicants enrolled in other curricula, according to their respective ranking, as specified in the Annex to this call for applications for each course.

The seats not covered by scholarships are awarded to suitable applicants until there are no more. In cases of equal merit, the younger applicant will get the scholarship.

Foreign applicants who hold scholarships funded by Italian or foreign institutions can enrol in these courses provided they are suitable for each course according to their ranking and up to the number of seats reserved. The applicants must be awarded the scholarship by 31 January 2014. By that date they are required to provide certification of said scholarship by fax to +39 02/6448.6289 or by e-mail at [dottorati@unimib.it](mailto:dottorati@unimib.it).

If there are additional seats, they can be made available, if the Teaching Staff so decides, according to the procedures for the admission of non-reserved seats.

Failure to complete the enrolment procedure to be carried out by following the instructions posted on the website of the University at <http://www.unimib.it/go/1678050163>, within the terms indicated in the margin of the ranking list will prevent the applicant from being admitted to the Programme. In this case, the vacancies are awarded to those who hold a good position in the ranking. These applicants will be notified by e-mail by the Office of Doctoral Studies.

If there are vacant places with a scholarship, candidates who had previously declined a place without a scholarship will be contacted in order of ranking.

The same thing will happen if someone gives up or forfeits admission to the course within one month from its beginning. In the event of cancellation or forfeiture within one month of the course, the student is not entitled to the scholarship payments.

In the event of placement in more than one classification, the applicant must choose only one PhD course.

Being enrolled in a PhD program means a total, full-time commitment, incompatible with permanent full-time work.

Doctoral students are required to participate in the activities planned for their curriculum, as indicated by the Board, and to carry out research activities assigned.

Enrolment in PhD Courses is incompatible with the simultaneous enrolment in undergraduate courses, postgraduate courses, advanced courses and Master courses, Internship Training courses, or other doctoral courses in Italy or abroad, excluding cases of specific international agreements and as provided by law as per agreements with the graduate schools of Medicine and Surgery. Those enrolled in undergraduate or postgraduate degree (Bachelor's Degree or Post-graduate Degree), who can rightfully enrol in a PhD course, are required to apply for a temporary career suspension.

#### **Art. 9 (Scholarships)**

The amount of the scholarship is € 13,638.47 per year gross of social security payable by the Scholar. The scholarship is exempt from local income tax and personal income tax (PIT).

In the event of scholarships with targeted research, the award will be given by the Academic Board will take into

account, in addition to the ranking, all the possible options of the applicant and the Committee's judgement on the skills of the same on the specific theme of research.

If none of the applicants accept to undertake the specific research project related to a scholarship or none, in the opinion of the Academic Board, is able to do it, the scholarship will not be awarded and the number of scholarships will be decreased.

The amount of the scholarship is increased for any period spent abroad, to the extent of 50%, for a maximum period of 18 months.

The scholarship lasts one year and shall be renewed for each year of the course, provided that the student pass verification for moving on to the next year.

The scholarship is paid in monthly instalments.

In order to take advantage of the scholarship, the winner must be in compliance with the following requirements:

- 1) Under Article 15, paragraph 16 of the Regulations for PhD research Courses, having a scholarship is compatible with other income, provided these do not exceed the maximum limit set out annually by the Board of Directors. For calendar year 2014, the gross annual personal income limit has been set at € 15,000.00.
- 2) The scholarships cannot be combined with other scholarships awarded for any purpose, except those awarded by national or foreign institutions, integrating with foreign travel, training or research by the participants.
- 3) The applicants cannot obtain a scholarship if they have done so in the past.

Public employees admitted to doctoral courses enjoy for the normal duration of the course the leave provided by collective bargaining or, for employees under public law, the special leave for study purposes, consistent with the requirements of the administration under Article 2 of the Law of 13 August 1984 n. 476, as amended, with or without pay and without express waiver, only if enrolled for the first time in a PhD course, regardless of the disciplinary scope.

#### **Art. 10 (Tuition and Fees)**

Doctoral students who do not hold a scholarship, are required to pay a fee amounting, for the academic year 2013/2014 to € 850.00 to be paid in 2 instalments, as follows:

- payment of the first instalment (€ 600.00) on enrolment;
- payment of the second instalment (€ 250.00) by **16 May 2014**.

To access and attend to the courses, students are required to pay accident insurance premium, amounting, for the academic year 2013/2014, to € 6.96. For those who do not hold a scholarship, the amount is included in the payment of € 850.00. For students with scholarships that amount will be subtracted from the first scholarship payment.

#### **Art. 11 (Obtaining the certificate)**

The certificate of Doctor of Philosophy is awarded on completion of the PhD research, when the students pass the final examination, which shall require the submission of a written dissertation (PhD thesis) which gives an account of an original research which significant scientific results.

#### **Art. 12 (Standards)**

For matters not covered in this announcement, the laws and regulations on the PhD are to be followed.

**Art. 13**  
**(Personal details)**

With reference to the provisions of Legislative Decree 30 June 2003, Nr. 196 "Code concerning the protection of personal details", on the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal details and, in particular, to the provisions of Article 13, the personal information provided by applicants is gathered at the University of Milan - Bicocca for the purposes of organising the entrance exam and are also processed in an automated format. The treatment of the same, for those admitted to the course shall also continue after enrolment for all purposes related to the management of the academic career.

Providing such data is necessary for the evaluation of the participation requirements. Failure to do so will prevent the applicants from taking the examination.
